

Guidelines for awarding BioExcel travel grants for ECCB 2018

BioExcel travel grants are fixed-amount support grants (500 EUR) to attend the BioExcel 2nd SIG Meeting: "Advanced Simulations for Biomolecular Research" @ ECCB 2018. Please check the eligibility criteria, how to apply and the terms and conditions before applying.

Note: We encourage all travel grant applicants to actively pursue other sources of funding as the number of travel grants are limited and the process is highly competitive. Please carefully consider the eligibility criteria and the application instructions.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for a BioExcel travel grant:

- You must be a student or early career scientist from an academic institution.
- You have registered for the BioExcel 2nd SIG Meeting
- You have submitted an abstract for the BioExcel 2nd SIG meeting, and it has been accepted for presentation
- You must not have received travel funding from BioExcel in the past 12 months.
- Your institute cannot be a partner on the BioExcel CoE.

How to apply

To apply for a BioExcel travel grant please:

- Register for the BioExcel 2nd SIG Meeting through http://eccb18.org/registration. IMPORTANT: Make sure to register for the SIGs/Workshops at the above address! Registering for the main conference only will _NOT_ let you attend the pre-meetings.
- Submit an abstract for the BioExcel 2nd SIG Meeting through the BioExcel event page https://bioexcel.eu/events/sig-bioexcel-2/

Terms and conditions

If your application is successful:



- The travel grant can only be used for the BioExcel 2nd SIG Meeting: "Advanced Simulations for Biomolecular Research" @ ECCB 2018.
- Travel grant is a reimbursement after the event.
- To claim reimbursement you must send the original receipts, a completed reimbursement form, and evidence of a completed feedback survey within 6 weeks of the event.
- Eligible costs: travel costs, accommodation and SIG/conference meeting registration fee(s)
- You are required to write a blog post (300-400 words, incl. 1 photo) upon your return. Your report may be published on the BioExcel website and publicised via social media.
